- \$117,000 OPW (Ohio Public Works) – Grant St. Culvert Replacement
- \$240,000 OPW Emergency Funding – Woodland Avenue Lift Station Repair
- \$300,000 TID (Transportation Improvement District) - Premier Drive reconstruction
- \$400,000 ODOT Systemic Safety Grant – 350' of missing link bike trail in downtown (Maple + Main Crossings) plus advanced crossings/signals/bump outs, etc. 2026 engineering, 2027 construction.
- \$1,057,000 in awarded grants this year.
- SC Land Bank and Clyde have completed our joint application for the Welcome Home Ohio program and are waiting for the application period to open.
- Smart Thermostat Program – 20 people enrolled so far.
- Cameras at the Park have been installed and have already caught one set of vandals. Thanks to CLP, Parks, and IT for their efforts.

FINANCE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Weasner reported the following:

- Auditors are scheduled to arrive next week
- OpenGov software for budgeting; training is scheduled for next week
- We are starting with the automated readings; it is throwing the schedule a little off for the big consumers, but we are keeping an eye on that; their days fluctuate a day or two but that will be straightened out

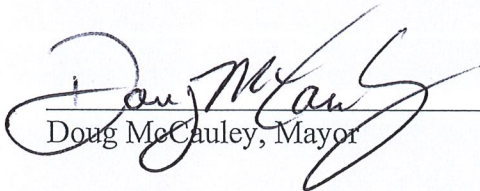

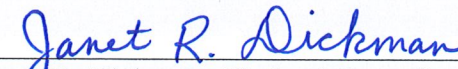
