

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-46

**AN ORDINANCE TO RESCIND CHAPTER 1519 (FIREWORKS)
FROM THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CLYDE,
OHIO.**

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly has enacted House Bill 172 which amends Ohio fireworks laws; and

WHEREAS, Governor Mike Dewine signed House Bill 172 into law on November 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to Ohio fireworks laws impacts the possession, use, and sale of fireworks; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 172 went into effect on July 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clyde, through its City Council, has passed numerous Ordinances thru the years which together, comprise specific Chapters of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Clyde, Ohio, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Clyde, through its City Council, wishes to repeal Chapter 1519 of the Codified Ordinances that are in conflict with House Bill 172.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1519 (Fireworks) be repealed. As a result of repealing this chapter contained within part fifteen (15) of the of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Clyde, Ohio, law enforcement will enforce the state code as it exists or as it may be amended concerning the possession, use, and sale of fireworks;

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in effect on and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by law.
