

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-10
CITY OF CLYDE, OHIO

AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CAPITAL FUND FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING NEW FIRE APPARATUS.

WHEREAS, this Council desires to establish a fire apparatus replacement fund, for the future purpose of purchasing new fire apparatus.

WHEREAS, City Manager and Fire Chief have identified the need for such a fund in order to efficiently replace aging equipment and to preserve the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the Clyde Fire District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That a new fund be established and designated as the Fire Apparatus Replacement Fund (Fund 830). The fund is established to account for revenues and expenditures associated with the Clyde Fire Department's new apparatus purchases, including anticipated related funding.

SECTION 2. Fund 830 will be used for the sole purpose of purchasing new apparatus for the Clyde Fire Department.

SECTION 3. That revenues received to the fund will be from fund transfers, grants, donations, or other sources.

SECTION 4. That One Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) from the Fire Department 2026 Capital Outlay line be deposited into the Fire Apparatus Replacement Fund 830 upon passage.
