

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-35

CITY OF CLYDE, OHIO

DECLARING A 2015 FORD EXPLORER INTERCEPTOR AS SURPLUS PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING ITS TRANSFER TO THE NORTH BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR NOMINAL CONSIDERATION.

WHEREAS, Section 2-1 of the City Charter provides that the City may sell, lease, mortgage, hold, manage, and control property as its interests may require, and the City possesses broad home rule authority under Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 governs the disposition of municipal personal property no longer needed for public use, and the City Council, as the legislative authority of the City, is authorized to direct the disposition of surplus municipal property; and

WHEREAS the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City and serves a public purpose to transfer a surplus vehicle to the North Baltimore Police Department and that such transfer is consistent with the City's authority and the intent of applicable law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds and declares that a 2015 Ford Explorer Interceptor, VIN No. 1FM5K8AR7FGC67045, formerly assigned to the Clyde Police Department (the "Vehicle"), is surplus personal property of the City of Clyde that is no longer needed for municipal purposes within the meaning of Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15.

SECTION 2. This Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to transfer title to the Vehicle to the North Baltimore Police Department for nominal consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the transfer of the Vehicle.

SECTION 4. The transfer shall be made on an "as-is, where-is" basis, without warranty of any kind, express or implied, as to the condition, fitness, or merchantability of the Vehicle. The North Baltimore Police Department shall be responsible for all costs associated with the transfer, including, but not limited to, title transfer fees, registration fees, and transportation costs.
